Job Title: Boat Pond Volunteer

Position Duties and Responsibilities:

- Works in the boathouse at Warnock Commons and Model Boat Pond to monitor and lend remote control boats and self-sailors to visitors.

- Deliver brief trainings for the boat operations and pond safety measures.
- Answer general questions about the history of the Astoria Train Depot.
- Keeps the boat fleet in working order.
- Acts as a Museum ambassador by answering questions, directing people to the Museum, and sharing information about educational programs.

Characteristics and Experiences:

- Must enjoy speaking with the public
- Ability and willingness to complete remote control boat training and rental software training
- Knowledge of the concepts of sailing or willingness to learn

Additional Qualifications:

- Must be 18 years of age or older
- Must successfully pass a criminal background check
- Must be willing to become a member of the Columbia River Maritime Museum
- Ability to work independently

Physical Requirements:

- Ability to bend, stoop, reach, and lift heavy or bulky items with or without accommodations
- Ability and willingness to work outside in different climates and in a kiosk
